

## 2017 Request for Applications: ASRP/AGE-WELL Postdoctoral Award

### 1. Program Objective

This program is designed to support trainees through the AGE-WELL (Aging Gracefully Across Environments Using Technology to support Wellness, Engagement and Long Life) Network of Centres of Excellence Training Program in partnership with the Alzheimer Society of Canada.

### 2. Mechanisms of Support

The funding partners, [AGE-WELL](#) NCE and the [Alzheimer Society Research Program](#), will co-fund up to **two Postdoctoral Fellows each in the amount of \$93,000 over two years.**

Awardees will be required to fulfill the requirements of the AGE-WELL NCE Training Program.

### 2. Mechanisms of Support and Eligibility

The [Alzheimer Society Research Program](#) (ASRP) in partnership with AGE-WELL NCE will fund:
